What We Do

Viewfield Garden Collective welcomes isolated, disadvantaged, unemployed people, and those seeking a safe space; it is one of the few such places locally. It grows fresh produce, which is offered to the community through donation, to help support the project.

Our charity supports people who may feel left out or vulnerable through:

- **Learning and education** in gardening and conservation—especially for those facing mental health challenges
- **Community and belonging**, by caring for one another and the garden
- **Health and wellbeing**, with gentle outdoor activities and friendly connection
- **Environmental care**, through increasing biodiversity, regenerating soil, and reducing the presence and use of plastic

A board of trustees governs the charity. The garden is cared for by:

- Trustees
- Paid staff
- Volunteers and community members

VGC operates under a long-term [land agreement](#), granting access to a designated garden space at Viewfield House, which includes:

- A large polytunnel with workshop and cooking area
- Flower and vegetable beds across three terrace levels
- A footpath linking the garden to town and walking routes

- Adults aged 16+ who support our aims
- Junior members under 16 (non-voting)
- Volunteer groups or charities approved by the Board
